We walked around the school grounds to look for signs of autumn and the different plants which grow in the school outdoor areas.

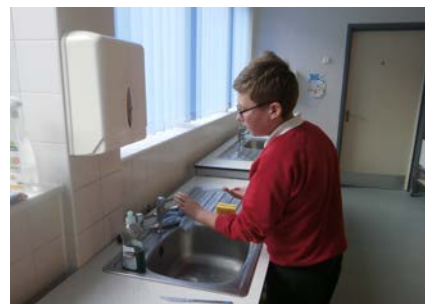


Great Fire of London
